The skills to create effective and professional page layout for publications.

After completing this one-day course, students will know how to:

- Use, modify and edit master page objects
- Arrange objects on layers; lock, unlock, show and hide layers; move objects between layers
- Draw custom shapes; draw and edit picture frames; fit objects to frames and frames to objects
- Work with a variety of imported file formats
- Add colour swatches; edit swatches; use the gradient panel
- Apply effects to text and graphics
- Identify and export files in a variety of formats

The target student for this course should be comfortable using a personal computer and working within either the Microsoft Windows or Macintosh environments. The target learner for this course is someone who has a basic understanding of Adobe InDesign. We recommend that students attend our Adobe InDesign Basic Level course before choosing the Advanced Level.
